- On 8/4/2017 members visited ASHRAM home for challenged children & donated medicine, food, toys, basic needs & spend a day with them.

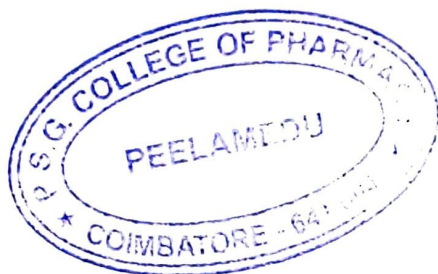

"A small act of kindness can make a big difference".

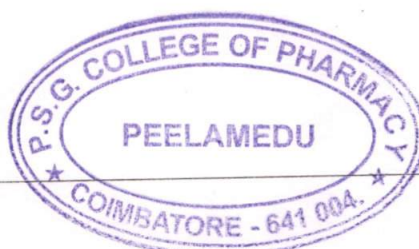

Students contribution : Rs.15,000/-

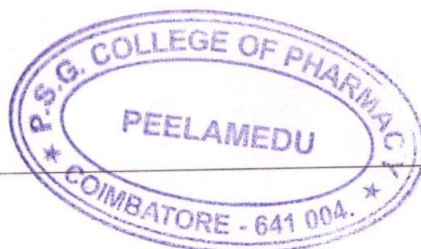
Summary:


Title of the event : Providing lunch to the old aged people at Cheshire homes

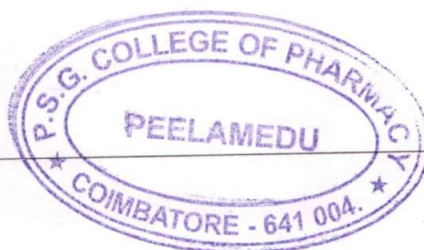

ValarKarangal strongly believes that giving is not just about making a donation; it's about making a change. Marching towards the goal, the following events were organised successfully.

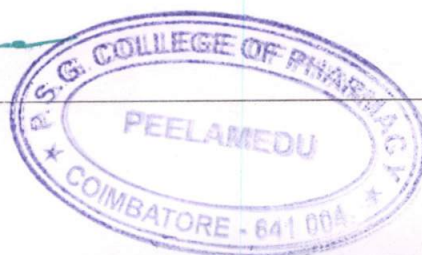
Title of the event : Act out to Hunger

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
Title of event : Tobacco awareness program & Career guidance program

Students contribution : Rs.300/-

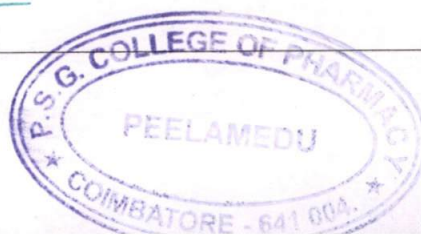

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Date : 20/02/20

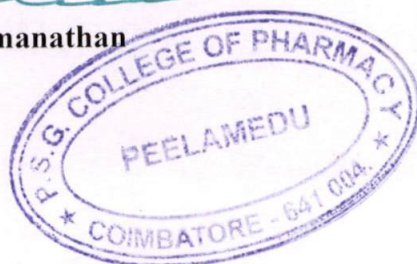
