

REPORT ON THE 1ST CPE OF 2022- MODULE -1 HELD ON 22 FEBRUARY 2022






The session was followed by "Inquiry Based Learning" on activities regarding heart failure and anti-arrythmic drugs to enlighten the knowledge.








The next session was "Inquiry Based Learning" which started at 11.00 am and the session ended by 1pm.



REPORT ON THE 5th CPE OF 2022- MODULE -5 HELD ON 29th JULY 2022



REPORT ON THE 6th CPE OF 2022- MODULE -6 HELD ON 29 AUGUST 2022







REPORT ON THE 4TH CPE OF 2022- MODULE -4 HELD ON 27 JUNE 2022


