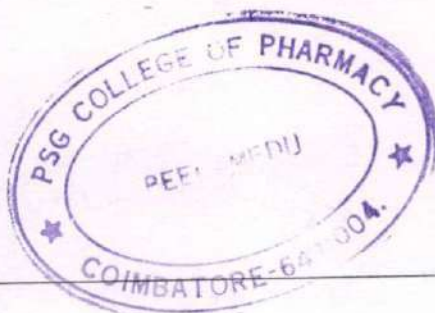


The session was followed by **“Inquiry Based Learning”** on activities regarding heart failure and anti-arrhythmic drugs to enlighten the knowledge.

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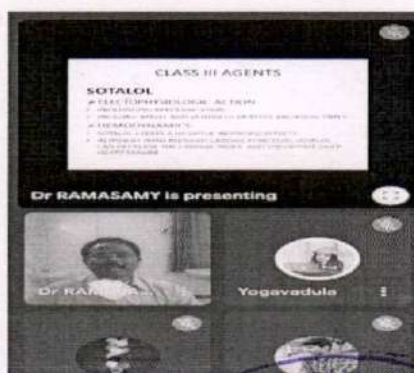
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**REPORT ON THE 2<sup>nd</sup> CPE OF 2022- MODULE -2 HELD ON 28 MARCH 2022**

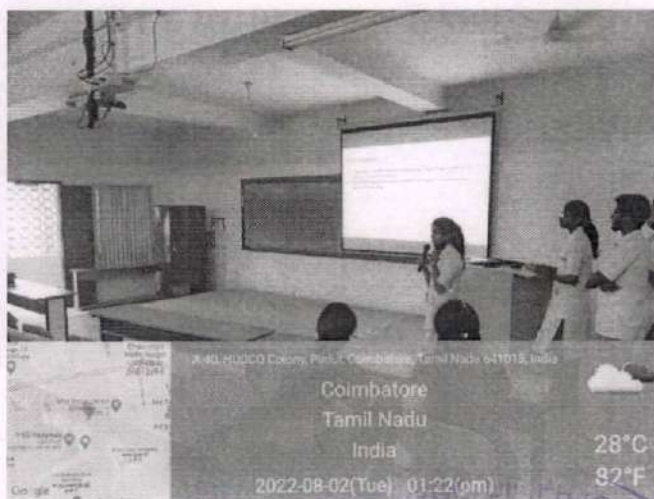
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**REPORT ON THE 5<sup>th</sup> CPE OF 2022- MODULE -5 HELD ON 29<sup>th</sup> JULY 2022**

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**REPORT ON THE 6<sup>th</sup> CPE OF 2022- MODULE -6 HELD ON 29 AUGUST 2022**

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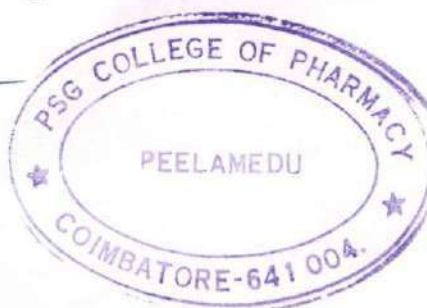
