FEEDBACK ANALYSIS REPORT – 2022 - 2023

The feedback analysis for syllabus, Teaching, Learning and Evaluation Process from stakeholders was collected. The new syllabus for B.Pharmacy was prescribed by Pharmacy Council of India in the year 2017 and for Pharm D in the year 2022. The feedback is collected based on syllabus, its content, academic flexibilty, efficiency and planning in carrier guidance to provide various skills for the students during their programme. The feedback was collected using a set of questions based on the content of the syllabus for all programmes, like UG, PG and Pharm D from the students, also from alumni and staffs.

The response and answers for each question, the stakeholders should choose from strongly agree to strongly disagree and neutral. Generally the feedback was mixed response with all stakeholders. The feedback was mainly satisfactory and good among the students, where they all agree about the syllabus content, Continuous internal assessment, Internship program and carrier guidance event, classroom and lab facilities. They strongly agree on the parameter facilities provided for extra and co curricular activities. They also responded neutral for ICT Tools Utilisation and hostel facilities.

RECOMMENDATIONS AND SCOPE OF IMPROVEMENT

The major recommendations to improve the teaching and learning were requirement in syllabus updation, giving importance to all the subjects, soft skill and Communication classes with carrier guidance for better placements. They suggested to give guidance for the university and competitive exams preparation.
