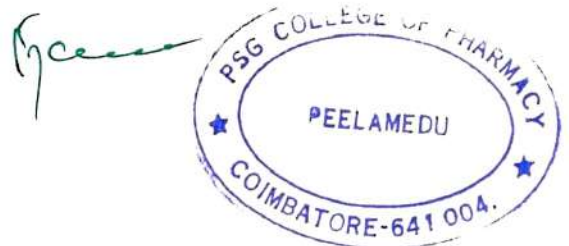
DAY 2:
