General free health checkup was done for public and main complaints noticed among the adult population were related to back pain, knee pain and general body pain, dry cough, gastric ulcer and eye care. Minor ailments were treated symptomatically. All adults were screened for hypertension, Diabetes and BMI. Patients with new findings and poor adherence to the old treatment were referred to higher canters for further need.
