1. Workshops and Training Sessions:

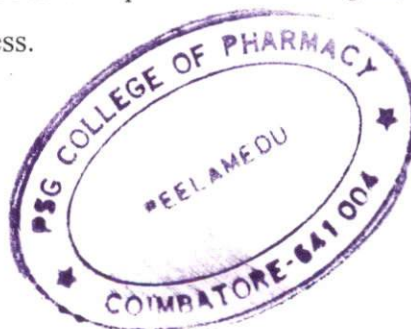
- Conducted interactive workshops on fire safety fundamentals, including identifying common fire hazards, proper use of fire extinguishers, and evacuation techniques.
